Important Notice about changes to our CLA Church Licence please read

There have been some changes to our CLA Church Licence which covers us for things such as photocopying, use of songs for worship, videos and music. The terms of our licence require us to periodically submit a report detailing our usage on various things such as the hymns and songs that we use for worship and how often they are used. We are now also required to report details of when we take photocopies from any non-music publication and what genres of music we use.

We already have a system in place to record information about hymns and songs that are used during worship. To assist us record the information that we require for photocopying and different music genres, please can you help us in the following ways:

Photocopying

If you make any photocopies from a non-music publication, please enter the details that are required into the blue and purple exercise book that is next to the photocopier at the time that you do the photocopying.

Use of Music

Please email Tom Crocombe with the date and details of the genre of music that you use in any church related activity. Please do this either before or immediately after use. Tom's email

We know that sometimes these requirements are a bit inconvenient, but it is very important that we abide by the conditions of our licence as the consequences can be a potentially heavy fine or our licence being revoked, neither of which we can afford or allow to happen.
